

VA, Affordable Care Act and You

What is the Affordable Care Act?

The Affordable Care Act, also known as the health care law, was created to expand access to coverage, control health care costs and improve health care quality and care coordination. The health care law does not change VA health benefits or Veterans' out-of-pocket costs. To learn more about ACA log on to VA's website at www.va.gov/health/aca. Three things you should know:

- VA wants all Veterans to receive health care that improves their health and wellbeing.
- If you are enrolled in VA health care, you don't need to take additional steps to meet the health care law coverage standards. The health care law does not change VA health benefits or Veterans' out-of-pocket costs.
- 3. If you are not enrolled in VA health care, you can apply at any time.



Veterans Enrolled in VA Health Care

The good news is that Veterans enrolled in VA health care programs have health coverage that meets the new health care law's standard. You do not have to take any additional steps to have health coverage.

Veterans Not Enrolled in VA Health Care

Veterans not currently enrolled in VA health care program can apply for enrollment at any time.

Family Members

VA offers health care benefits for certain family members of Veterans through programs such as the Civilian Health and Medical Program of the Department of Veterans Affairs (CHAMPVA) and the Spina Bifida program.

Education Classes for Veterans in Pain

The founder of The American Chronic Pain Association (ACPA) is coming to the Nebraska-Western Iowa Health Care System (VA NWI HCS) to offer educational classes for Veterans in pain. *Veterans In Pain* is a one-time event focused on teaching Veterans on ways to regain control of their life despite pain. Penny Cowan, founder of ACPA will share tools you can use to help communicate with your healthcare providers. Classes are open to all Veterans. Classes will be offered in Grand Island and Omaha and will be broadcast via Telehealth to Community Based Outpatient Clinics (CBOC) in Lincoln, Holdrege, and North Platte. Veterans must pre-register to attend by contacting the American Chronic Pain Association at 800-533-3231. *NOTE, these classes are NOT documented as a medical appointment in the Veteran's medical record, therefore Veterans who attend are NOT eligible for travel pay. Following is a list of dates and times when Veterans In Pain is scheduled:

- Grand Island August 29th 9:30 AM 3:00 PM, Building 6 (located south of the main VA building)
- Omaha August 30th 9:30 AM 3:00 PM, Education Conference Room. This class will be broadcast, via Telehealth at Community Based Outpatient Clinics in Lincoln (Site 3), Holdrege and North Plattes.

Fargo VA Health Care System to Host Fall Prevention Classes

'Stepping On' is a fall prevention class that will begin at the Fargo VA Health Care System on September 6th. This innovative 7-week session will take place once a week in room 3154 at the Fargo VA from 10 am to noon. 'Stepping On' is a class for people who have fallen or have a fear of falling, who are still living in their own home, and are able to walk without a walker or cane," explained Amanda Hoffer, physical therapist at the Fargo VA.

This class will provide valuable information with a focus on prevention of falls. Participants will receive ankle weights and will get the chance to exercise with a physical therapist. In addition, guest speakers, to include a pharmacist, vision specialist and a police officer will be part of the program to provide Veterans with valuable information regarding fall prevention.
