7 Days of recognition - 365 days committed to safe care

Patient Safety Awareness Week is an annual education and awareness campaign for health care safety.

Prior to 1999, virtually all healthcare organizations engaged in investigations of events that caused harm to patients.

The focus was on individuals, rather than on system level vulnerabilities and events that had combined in an unfortunate sequence to cause an incident to occur.

VA's patient safety goal is simple: Reduce and Prevent inadvertent harm to patients as a result of their care. Reducing or eliminating harm to patients is the real key to patient safety.

Efforts that focus exclusively on eliminating errors will fail. Human error can never be totally eliminated. VA's focus is to design systems that are "fault tolerant," so that when an individual error occurs, it does not result in harm to a patient.

Did you know that women are the fastest growing group within the Veteran population?

In the past decade, more than 181,000 women Veterans have served in Iraq and Afghanistan war zones, often attached to combat units in a wide array of positions, including medics, transportation officers, and military police. They have demonstrated extraordinary skills and bravery in defending our country.

Today, VA is working tirelessly to ensure that women receive the benefits and high quality health care they have earned through their service. Women serve in every branch of the military, representing 15 percent of today's active duty military and nearly 18 percent of National Guard and Reserve forces. By 2020, VA estimates women Veterans will constitute more than 12 percent of the Veteran population. To increase Veteran and family awareness of the VA's increasing use of telehealth services, Telehealth Fairs are planned at all St. Cloud VA Health Care System locations in March. During the events, Veterans can see telehealth tools in action at the Community Based Outpatient Clinic locations in Alexandria, Brainerd, and Montevideo. Veterans will also be able to meet clinic staff and tour the facility, participate in health and hearing screenings, and apply for enrollment in VA health care. Care Anywhere – Reaching out to Homeless Veterans

Care Anywhere is a program created by the Iowa City VA Health Care System in 2011 to provide homeless Veterans in rural areas with the same health care they would receive at a VA medical center. The Care Anywhere program is designed to help homeless Veterans overcome barriers to accessing quality health care VA staff use iPads, jetpacks, and Skype, a user friendly telecommunication program, to connect Veterans with providers. Currently, Care Anywhere is able to reach all of the Iowa City service areas, which covers 33 eastern Iowa counties, 16 western Illinois counties and one northern Missouri county. Eliminating Veterans Homelessness is a priority for VA and the Iowa City program is one that moves us towards achieving that goal.
